Mr. Vincent has asked me to give an opinion on the report of the Committee for Research in Problems of Sex which I am returning herewith. The research work shown in this report is most excellent and is worthy of continuation as such. I think it would be difficult to bring together a group of men better qualified to work on these problems or to arrange problems of greater importance for investigation. On the other hand I do not see the immediate practical application of the results of this work, though practical applications may emerge in course of time. I assume however that it is an opinion on the value of the work as such that you wish and not an opinion as to its practical application. I can recommend most strongly that aid for this work be continued as research of the highest type.
