With RSM to the Waldorf for a brief chat with Lawrence Saunders on the subject of Kinsey's plans for publication. I told S. that I had told K. that a medical publisher seemed to me to be the best auspices and that I did not wish to comment further on the situation in view of the fact that I had told Kinsey it was his decision and that I would not interfere. S. feels that joint publication or joint distribution between a regular med. publishing co. and a non-medical publisher would have some unfortunate implications and consequences, and is a bit disturbed because this type of publication seems to be among the alternatives in Kinsey's mind.
