Spent at Williamsburg attending the regular meeting of the Trustees. This was one of the most interesting and enlightening meetings GKS has attended. Four large items, each over a million dollars, including the IHD 1948 budget, were presented. The total of all the items included in the docket amounted to more than \$9,000,000. The IHD item caused no adverse criticism and, in fact, the only comments made were to the effect that work in population is still not an integral part of the IHD program. JER 3d was of the opinion that it should become interested in this field and should attempt work, from a practical angle, in population control. GKS promised to give the matter early consideration, and said it would be brought to the attention of the Board of Scientific Directors and he would later report to the Trustees.
