Final meeting of the Board of Scientific Directors. Business was dispatched promptly and there was a good deal of discussion of a number of points which were brought up for attention of the Board, particularly the question of population as a field which might interest the IHD. \* Dr. Reed commented that this was an extremely difficult field to enter and he would recommend that the IHD go into it with very considerable caution. In other words, he would recommend feeling our way as we proceed. He also suggested that perhaps an easy way to enter the field would be to sponsor one or two research projects centered around some university, on a grant-in-aid basis. Touching upon Puerto Rico, he suggested that an experiment might be carried on there by such a university research group.
