Excerpt from Makinsky's letter of April 28th, to TBA

Prof. Marc Bloch

In reply to my telegraphic inquiry (from Marseille) Prof. Bloch wired me as follows: "Have received special mission from French Government Stop American Consulate Lyon prepared grant visae immediately for myself, my wife and younger children Stop Visaw for my mother and my other three children who are over 18 will be granted only on June 5th stop We feel it is impossible to travel separately Stop Up to April 19th my address is Fougères Bourgdhem Creuse.

The Consul at Lyon confirmed this when I saw him on April 13th. I am completely out of sympathy with B., as, unless he is willing to wait until the late fall, he will never be able to get eight places on the same boat.
