DETAIL OF INFORMATION:

The purpose of the present action is to reinstate a grant approved on October 2, 1941 - RA H 4165, which provided \$3,750 to enable the New School to invite Professor Jean Wahl to join its faculty for a two-year period beginning approximately October 1, 1941. This fund was to revert to the Foundation if not taken up on or before December 15, 1941. Professor Wahl's travel to the United States was delayed and the grant therefore was cancelled on December 15, 1941.

Word now has been received from the New School of approval by the State Department of Professor Wahl's visa, and arrangements for his travel will be made as soon as the grant is reinstated. The termination of the previous action on December 15 was intended to imply no lack of continuing interest in Professor Wahl's case. Rather it was fixed in the belief that if he had not been able to secure passage to the United States by that time, he would not be able to do so.
