The purpose of the Foundation is to raise money from the public sector, including donations from individuals, corporations and other foundations. The Foundation maintains a group of Advisors made up of health professionals and representatives of the private sector from Latin America, who will advise the directors, but who do not have voting power as such.

The Foundation maintains informal linkages with the "Union Latinoamericana Contra Enfermedades Transmisible Sexualmente y SIDA" (ULACETS) translated as - the Latin American Union to Control Sexually Transmitted Diseases and AIDS. This organization maintains offices throughout Latin America, and its members provide technical advice and clinical expertise to Ministries and community clinics where research and treatment on Sexually Transmitted Diseases and HIV is conducted. It is the intention that the Foundation will use this institution as one of several community based organizations (CBO's) in Latin America that provide HIV and AIDS related services in the region. The anticipated outcome of such funding will be to

produce scientifically measurable improvements in STD/HIV treatment and education. Once the money is channeled to ULACETS or similar institutions, that organization is free to contract with U.S. universities to provide technical assistance in areas such as economic cost analyses on the impact of AIDS, evaluation of HIV prevention and education programs, training for health professionals and related studies.

All requests for funding from CBO's and ULACETS will be presented to the directors and advisors of the organization for their review. Pending the decision of these individuals, recommendations for funding will be made and the directors will approve or disapprove requests based on these recommendations.
