Dr. Kinsey, RSM - lunch

Kinsey goes over some of the figures I had taken from his presentation here in New York and confirms them. His number of full cases is constantly growing. Now has about 8500 and the battle now is in securing competent interviewers. Especially favorable reception in the suburbs of Philadelphia. First book will probably be ready about a year from now. Psychoanalysts thinks Kinsey's work will advance the status of psychoanalysis by 50 years. I am inclined to think that it will change a good many things. Having examined and taken 18 measurements on 152,000 ~~wasps~~, Kinsey is not daunted by a rather large order of detail work.
