Dear Richards:

Doctor Sawyer has just told me that Strode and O'Brien learned in Paris from French authorities that until the armistice between France and Germany is terminated no person will be allowed to leave Unoccupied France whose citizenship originated in Germany, Belgium or Luxembourg and who was an emigré in France at the time that the armistice was signed. This categorically excludes the possibility of Meyerhof's being allowed to leave France. He has gone to the Marine Biological Laboratory at Banyuls-sur-Mer (Pyrenees-Orientales, France) where I presume he could be reached for any communication you may wish to make. Since no one can forecast when it will suit the Germany to conclude terms of peace with France, the future is entirely uncertain.
