My dear Dr. Gregg:

You will be interested to know that we have signed the contract for the publication of the first book with W. B. Saunders Company. We decided that there was definite advantage in being associated with a company known to the public as distinctly medical publishers. We think we will have a very dignified treatment, both in the way the book is put up and the way in which it is presented to the public.

There has been some delay in the application from the President of Indiana University for a special grant to cover the library expenses. The President has been away a good deal since I presented the matter to him last month. He tells me today that the request has finally gone through. I hope that we can still handle it on this budget. We have secured a considerable amount of very important material since you were here, and our library becomes of increasing importance as we prepare the final material on our book.

We have brought in a second high-speed stenographer and at the rate we are going now we anticipate that the entire manuscript will be done before the middle of July; this means publication in November. We are all very enthusiastic about the possibilities.
