Dear Mr. Appleget:

It appears the only possibility of getting  
X Dr. Hedwig Hintze and Dr. Hugo Sinzheimer out of  
Holland would be to have them ~~secure~~ Cuban visas.  
Such visas would permit them to get to Lisbon where  
it is entirely possible that they might get regular  
American visas. If this were not possible, they  
could get the American visas after they landed in  
Cuba.

We have talked this situation over with Mr.  
Makinsky, who believes that this plan would work. It  
involves additional expense, probably \$500 each. Don't  
you feel that the additional expense would be justified  
if we could thus bring these scholars to safety?
