My dear Doctor Rose:-

I think you will be glad to learn of the very marked success, which one of our appointees, Doctor HEISENBERG, has achieved. I have just had a letter from Professor Niels Bohr, in which he tells me that Doctor Kramers, who has been for the last ten years his personal assistant at Copenhagen, has accepted a post as professor of theoretical physics at the University of Utrecht. Bohr has decided to call as Kramers' successor with him Dr. Heisenberg who has, as I told you when I was in New York, made a notable contribution to the theory of atomic structure during the period when he was a fellow of the Board. It looks as though our support of Heisenberg has been a really very fine thing not only for himself but for his science.

While I am on the subject, another and somewhat minor success is the case of a present fellow, Doctor MANDELBJOJT, about him I have already written you. It may amuse you to see a placard posted in the
