My dear Sir:-

I am directed by the Board of Governors to inform you that your letter of 17th June, addressed to Sir Robert Falconer, has been laid before them and that the Board gratefully accept the donation referred to therein of an annual payment not exceeding \$17,500 Canadian funds in any one year for support, over a five-year period beginning 1 July, 1932, of the development of Public Health Nursing Education in this University, (your Appropriation RF 32080).

It is noted that it is your understanding in making this appropriation that the previous negotiations on a different basis between the University and the Foundation have terminated, and that your present action does not carry any implications for support beyond the five-year period.

Miss Russell, the Director of our Department of Public Health Nursing, has, I believe, informed you of her plans for organization, and in connection with these the Board have appointed a new member of the staff to assist Miss Russell during 1932-33 at a salary of \$2,500, payable out of the first
