In a letter which I have recently received from Mr. Georges-
Risler, Vice-President of the Comité National de Défense contre la Tubercu-
lose, he makes the following statements:

"Your services were so well organized that we only had
to persevere and follow the roads you had mapped out, and the
results seem to us so remarkable that we have decided to keep
in its entirety the whole organization which you bequeathed to
us.

"We are striving to collect the complementary funds
which will enable us, beginning this year, in spite of the
reduction in your contribution, to avoid cutting down the
services which were so well organized by you."

This is indeed a great satisfaction to me as many people
stated that the Comité National, as soon as 1924 came with the decrease
in our subsidy, would immediately decrease the personnel and the work.
I have personally felt that this would not happen and I am glad to see
that my opinion has been justified.
