My dear Professor Bohr:

At the meeting of the International Education Board held on Monday, November 19, the officers of the Board were authorized to confer with you with a view to maturing a plan for the enlargement and further equipment of the Institute for Theoretical Physics of the University of Copenhagen, and were authorized also to commit the Board, in their discretion, in a sum not to exceed Forty thousand Dollars (\$40,000) for this purpose.

It is our understanding that you will go over the matter of building and equipment in detail, with a view to arriving at a definite estimate of what will be required to meet your needs, and that you will take up also the question of provision for the maintenance of your institution. The contribution from the International Education Board will be made with the understanding that the maintenance of the institution is to be provided for from other sources.
