As you have seen from Chauncey Belknap's letter to you of June 15, 1961, we have just won a spectacular victory on the Villa Serbelloni, a victory which I think is unprecedented in Italy--and we are now clothed with a legal entity on Italian soil and sufficient legal references to dazzle the local yokels. I am afraid that as Acting President you will have to write letters of thanks to Mr. Belknap (who deserves all the credit), to Edward Mag at the American Embassy, to Ambassador Reinhardt, del Balzo in the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and to Biamonte, the lawyer who carried the ball for us in Rome. Such letters may smooth the way for another victory on the tax-exemption front. Would you like me to draft such letters for you?
