MR. ROCKEFELLER
JR'S PLEDGE OF
JANUARY 19, 1923

D. Rockefeller, Jr: (Document of Record No. 7)

"January 19, 1923

International Education Board,
Richmond, Virginia

Gentlemen:

I have learned with pleasure of
the granting of a charter to your
Board under the laws of the State of
Virginia.

I am much interested and impressed
with the necessity for the work the
Board proposes to do, as declared by
its corporate purposes set out in its
charter as follows:

'The purposes for which the
corporation is formed are the
promotion and/or advancement
of education, whether institu-
tional or otherwise, throughout
the world.'

For the purpose of aiding the
Board in the carrying out of such
corporate purposes, I hereby pledge
to it such part of the sum of \$200,000. ^{error} \$ 100,000
per year, for a period of ten years
commencing February 1, 1923 and ending
January 31, 1933, as in the opinion of
the Board may be needed by it. Payments
will be made from time to time upon
request from the Board, and in such
amounts within the pledge limits as the
Board may determine.
