The Director reported that Dr. M. C. Balfour had been assigned to make a thoroughly critical study of population as it might interest the International Health Division.

POPULATION

The Social Sciences has arranged for Dr. Notestein, Director of the Princeton Office of Population Research, School of Public and International Affairs, to go to Japan, China, Formosa and possibly Java and the Philippines to make a population survey, probably in the fall of 1948. According to present plans, Dr. Balfour and probably an officer from the Social Sciences will accompany Dr. Notestein, at least during part of the visits. It is hoped that out of this will come some sort of blueprint which will be useful to the Scientific Directors in charting possible future projects in this field.
