**Statement of Goals and Objectives  
of the Pan American AIDS Foundation**

1. To encourage collaboration between the non-governmental and private sectors from countries of the Pan American Health Region to confront the epidemic of HIV infection with a unified strategic plan for prevention, education, clinical therapy and resources management. Comprehensive systems of health care such as the San Juan AIDS Institute will serve as examples for implementing cost efficient AIDS health care delivery models in other Latin American Countries.
2. To strengthen the implementation of strategies for HIV prevention established by the Pan American Health Organization.
3. To coordinate activities with academic institutions, universities and the Latin American Union Against Sexually Transmitted Diseases and AIDS (ULACETS) and other appropriate institutions.
4. To raise funds from private sources and to allocate them through grants to strengthen the strategic AIDS activities of the member countries of the Pan American Health Region.
5. Criteria for the allocation of grants shall place as priority those which support development of:
  - ♦ Innovative prevention and education programs utilizing the mass media and training of educators, health and social service workers:
  - ♦ comprehensive health care management systems for AIDS patients:
  - ♦ alternatives to in-patient AIDS care including, home care, ambulatory care and hospice.
6. To provide state of the art technical assistance through Harvard University and other academic institutions to improve the effectiveness and evaluation of prevention, clinical and research activities.
- 7- To serve as a conduit for Debt for Health Swaps which will be modeled on the Debt for Education program which is now in place at Harvard University.
8. To host technical workshops in Spanish and Portuguese for NGO officials that will train them in proposal development and writing. This objective is in response to the needs articulated by our colleagues in Latin America.
