Dear Professor Volterra:

At a meeting of the International Education Board held May 26, 1924 the officers presented your letter of February 25th in which you nominate Mr. Enrico Fermi for a fellowship in science.

It gives me pleasure to inform you that the Board authorized its executive officers in their discretion to commit the Board to an appropriation of the sum not exceeding \$700 to Mr. Enrico Fermi to enable him to pursue his studies in theoretical physics at the University of Leiden, Leiden, Holland, for six months, beginning September 1, 1924.

In accordance with our custom this sum will be remitted to Mr. Fermi through you in two payments, the first payment being made on or about July 1, 1924 and the second on or about November 1, 1924.

Will you kindly inform Mr. Fermi of the Board's action in his case?
